



UCEED 2026 Syllabus (Tentative)

The Undergraduate Common Entrance Examination for Design (UCEED) 2026 will be conducted by IIT Bombay in January 2026 (tentative).

The exam will have two parts: Part A (Computer-based Test) & Part B (Drawing Test).

Part A – Computer-Based Test

- 1. Visualization and Spatial Reasoning**
 - Visualize and transform 2D shapes and 3D objects
 - Spatial relationships, rotations, symmetry, and patterns
- 2. Practical and Scientific Knowledge**
 - Scientific principles in daily life
 - Awareness of materials, physics in design context
- 3. Observation and Design Sensitivity**
 - Detect hidden properties in visuals and objects
 - Critical analysis, inference, attention to detail
- 4. Environment and Society**
 - Environmental, cultural, and social connections with design
 - Awareness of sustainability and usability
- 5. Analytical and Logical Reasoning**
 - Qualitative & quantitative reasoning
 - Pattern recognition, problem-solving, deductions
- 6. Language and Comprehension**
 - Reading and understanding Standard English
 - Grammar, vocabulary, comprehension skills
- 7. Creativity**
 - Verbal & non-verbal analogies, metaphors, symbols
 - Idea fluency and innovative thinking

Part B – Pen-and-Paper Drawing Test

- 1. Drawing**
 - Ability to draw products, people, or scenes in correct proportion
 - Perspective, composition, shading, and line quality

2. Design Aptitude

- Respond creatively to problem situations
- Idea generation, empathy, and practical design solutions
