
Please read the questions carefully and answers in the space provided






Stuff cloth to block the flow of water.




Connect the pipe to the leaking tap and change the water of the fish tank. This might take a couple of hours. In case of no flow, collect in a bucket and put in the fish tank.




Collect water in a bucket and use it to fill water balloons and be ready for the festival of Holi coming up in 2 days. The water can also be used to water plants.
