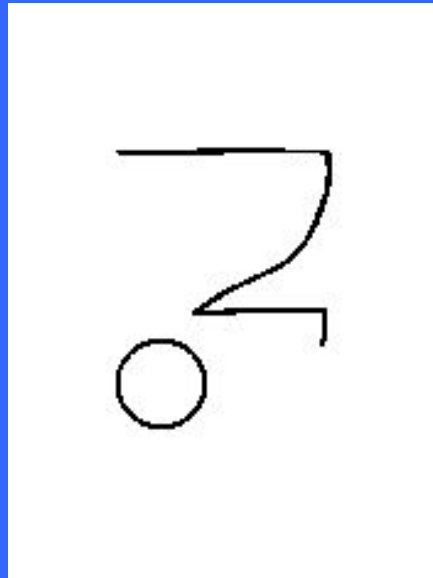
1. Doodling test

1. Studio Test - Doodling

- 15-20 frames of incomplete lines
- Used for psycho-analyses
- Need to express something
- Need to have captions
- Need to be tidy

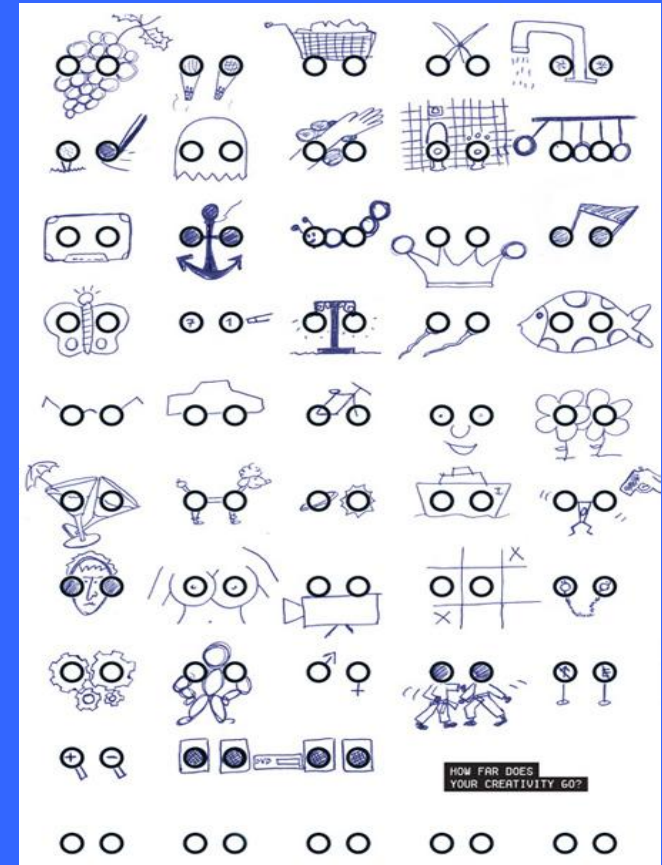
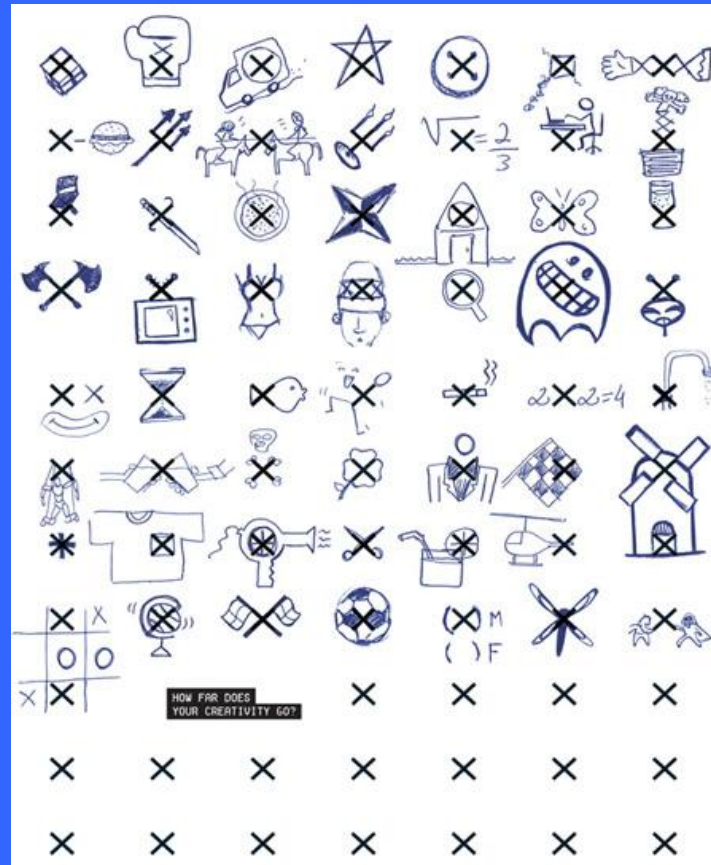
1. Studio Test – Doodling

2. Studio Test - Observation

- Testing awareness of 5 senses
- Eg 1- Visual - Video clip, Photos etc
- Eg 2- Touch – Identify objects
- Eg 3- Audio – Music clip
- Eg 4- Experiences at studio test

2. Studio Test - Observation



What are all things white you saw in the foyer?

What were the ingredients in the snack you had during break?



3. Studio Test – Material Handling

- One material is given and students are tested on use of that material.
- Most popular is clay. E.g. make a alien out of clay.

4. Studio Test – 3D Models

- In B.Des. - 3D Model per brief & materials
- Judged on-
 1. model suffices the brief
 2. how well materials are used
 3. how well you understand and solve the problem

4. Studio Test – Specialization

- In M.Des., the third test is based on specialization chosen.

E.g. In Animation- write a story of Akbar & Barack Obama in walking in a garden. Show this in 6 frames.

- It may be 3D modeling / Sensory test / visualization & drawing skill test / problem solving test etc

5. Studio Test – Other Tests

- Material handling E.g. Best out of Waste
- Other psychometric tests E.g. “Out of box” thinking questions.
- Other observation tests- cultural, on the spot tests etc.
